HVGS Visual & Performing Arts Scholarship

Visual & Performing Arts Scholarships may be awarded to applicants with talent and creative abilities in either Visual Arts or Drama.

Students must be committed to studying the relevant subject to HSC level and must be fully involved in exhibitions and/or performances and other appropriate co-curricular activities.

Recipients of the Visual & Performing Arts Scholarship must show their ability to balance their creativity, initiative and technique through performance, exhibition or publication.

Recipients must demonstrate their desire to pursue individual goals while upholding the School's values and setting a good example to fellow students.

The applicant's full range of interests and activities should be carefully documented and, where possible, supported by evidence of awards, prizes or testimonials.

Visual & Performing Arts Scholarships are available to all students (internal and external) who will be entering any Secondary level, Years 7-12.

Scholarships take the form of a remission in fees from 25%, 50%, or 75% depending on the outcome of the process.

Scholarships are not automatically awarded to other siblings of the same family; each student is considered on his/her own merits.

APPLICATION PROCESS & REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Please apply by completing the Visual & Performing Arts Scholarship Application Form. The following statements and documentation will be required:

1. Academic achievement including latest two School Reports and Naplan Test Results.
2. Achievements, Certificates or Awards to support the applicant's level of achievement, talent and creative abilities in either Visual Arts or Drama.
3. A reference or statement of support from the applicant's current School Principal.
4. Any other relevant information that testifies to the applicant's capacity to enhance the ethos and student culture of the School.

All applicants will receive a letter from the Principal advising the outcome of the application and next steps, if appropriate.

CRITERIA TO BE USED TO AWARD SCHOLARSHIPS

1. A complying application is submitted with all the required documentation.
2. The student applicant conducts themselves appropriately at the interview with the Principal, showing sound speaking and listening skills.
3. The student applicant has achieved outstanding visual or performing arts results for the most recent reporting period with positive and supporting teacher comments regarding the applicant as a learner.
4. Supporting documentation to indicate achievement at an outstanding level in visual or performing arts.
5. References attesting to the personal attributes of the student and the positive contribution the student will make to the ethos of the School.
