Enrolment Application Charges

Application Fee	\$250	Payable per application. All initial applications are processed within the School's Enrolment Policy. This fee is non-refundable.
Enrolment Bond	\$1,250	Payable upon acceptance of the School's Conditions of Enrolment. The Bond is refundable providing all conditions of enrolment are met. Please refer to our Enrolment Conditions (Clauses 9 and 10).

*Sibling Discounts

The eldest enrolled child in the family is considered to be the 1st child, 2nd eldest is considered 2nd child etc.

When the eldest child leaves the School, the 2nd child becomes the 1st child etc.

Building Fund

The Voluntary Building Fund is a tax-deductible donation that supports the development and ongoing maintenance of the School's facilities and innovative learning spaces. Donations to the Building Fund can be paid yearly or termly and are always greatly appreciated.

Other Charges

Other charges may apply. For example, overseas tours, textbooks etc.

Outdoor Education Program

The cost of the compulsory Outdoor Education Program is included in the tuition fees.

Payment of Fees

Fees are due and payable on the first day of each term, with the exception of Term 1 2022, unless an alternative payment arrangement is approved by the School.

Due dates for 2022 are:

- Term 1: Monday 7 February 2022
- Term 2: Wednesday 27 April 2022
- Term 3: Tuesday 19 July 2022
- Term 4: Tuesday 11 October 2022
- Term 4 Sundries: Friday 18 December 2022

TVET Courses

Charges for TVET courses are included in the School budget.

Withdrawal of Students

A full term's notice is required, in writing, to the Principal if a parent intends to withdraw a child. In default of such notice, the Enrolment Bond will be forfeited.

Payment Methods

Payment can be made via Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT), EFTPOS, credit card, cash or cheque. A 1% charge applies for credit card payments.
