SIBLING DISCOUNTS

Hunter Valley Grammar School offers a generous discount on fees for siblings from the same household who are attending the School at the same time. The eldest enrolled child in the family is considered to be the 1st child, 2nd eldest is considered 2nd child etc.

When the eldest child leaves the School, the 2nd child becomes the 1st child etc.

- Child 2 – **10% discount** on tuition fees
- Child 3 – **25% discount** on tuition fees
- Child 4 – **50% discount** on tuition fees
